

**RESOLUTION NO. 080116E**

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PERRY AND  
SPENCER AND SARAH PARKINSON**

**WHEREAS**, the Perry City Council finds that pursuant to Section 55.15 of the City Code of Ordinances, 2001, It is unlawful for a person to keep livestock within the city except by written consent of the Council or except in compliance with the city's zoning regulations, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has received a request from Spencer and Sarah Parkinson, that upon the completion of the purchase of land located at in the 2600 block of 1<sup>st</sup> Street containing nineteen plus acres, that they be allowed to raise livestock, and

**WHEREAS**, surrounding parcels are utilized for agricultural purposes and the addition of livestock seems appropriate for this parcel of ground, and

**WHEREAS**, the owners agree that all containment of the livestock shall be suitable for the species applied for and shall meet all building and fencing requirements set forth by the City of Perry Code of Ordinances, and

**WHEREAS**, the owners agree that housing structures for these animals shall be constructed as to minimize noise, smells or other similar nuisance and fencing shall be built and maintained to prevent such animals from being at large, and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement may be reviewed at any time throughout the life of the agreement and will be automatically reviewed upon receipt of a nuisance complaint to ensure the compliance with this agreement and the Perry Code of Ordinances, and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement between the City of Perry and Spencer and Sarah Parkinson is exclusive to the above mentioned property and exclusive to the ownership of the property by the Parkinson's.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Perry City Council approves the agreement between the City of Perry and Spencer and Sarah Parkinson to allow livestock within city limits upon the terms and condition of the Written Agreement.
