

### PHYSICAL SOCIAL DISTANCING

To the extent possible we will practice physical social distancing in the building. Students will stay with their same class for the duration of the school day.



### HAND WASHING

There will be multiple hand sanitizing stations located around the building. Classes will wash hands frequently during scheduled transitions.



#### CLEANING PROTOCOLS

Daily cleaning protocols will be implemented to clean classrooms and common areas. There will be routine cleaning of frequently touched areas. Additional cleaning products will be available in all classroom spaces.




# PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

All staff members will wear either a face shield and/or mask during the school day. It is highly recommended that students wear a mask during the school day.



#### **BUILDING MOVEMENT**

Visuals will be used in the building to safely space students while moving to different locations. Building schedules will be used to minimize the number of students transitioning at one time.



## STUDENT SUPPLIES

Individual student supplies will be used in most cases. When shared supplies and manipulatives are used students will wash their hands before and after use.



### WATER BOTTLES

Students will use personal water bottles to drink water during the day. Bottle filling stations will be used during the day to refill water bottles.

### LUNCHROOM



Students will stay with their class to eat lunch in the lunchroom. Classes will be physically spaced out. Students will be served lunch and use packaged plastic utensils. Students will wear a lanyard to be scanned to pay for their milk and/or lunch. Lunchroom seating and tables will be cleaned between grade levels.




### DROP OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

New detailed drop-off and pick-up procedures will be communicated prior to the start of the school year to ensure both student and staff safety. Procedures will include information for students riding a bus, riding with a parent, and/or walking.



### ACCESS TO BUILDING

Students being dropped off late will enter at the front door and met by a staff member. Students being picked up early will be walked to the front door by a staff member. To start the year volunteers will not be used in classrooms. This will limit contact for both students and staff members.



# **CLASSROOM SEATING**

Students will have assigned seating in classrooms. Classrooms will be structured with students facing the front of the classroom and spaced throughout the classroom.



### **TECHNOLOGY**

Students K-5 will have their own device to use in the classroom. Students will have access to either an I-Pad or Chromebook based on their grade level.

Additional details about safety and mitigation strategies will be communicated prior to the start of the school year, based on guidance from the Department of Education and Boone County Health Department.
